 - 1. Does the group have a prophet/founder who is revered by followers and claims to have special revelation from God or from angels?
 - 2. Are there authoritative writings or scriptures in addition to or instead of the Bible?
 - 3. Does the group view itself as the one *true* church, founded because the *true* gospel was lost in the early centuries of the church?
 - 4. What does the group believe regarding the Trinity? Is Jesus fully God, the second person of the Trinity? Is the Holy Spirit fully God, the third person of the Trinity?
 - 5. How does the group believe we are saved? By grace alone, through faith in Jesus Christ, or by faith plus good works?
 - 6. What belief does the group hold regarding life after death? What is its concept of Heaven and Hell?

- Let's go through our six questions...
 - Who is their founder?
 - Rev. Sun Myung Moon
 - "Humanity has to humbly listen to the voice of heaven and find the road of resolution directed by God. This country and its people must accept my teachings. This is not because I am trying to raise myself up, but because it is the will of God. God has revealed the principles of heaven through me, and He has given me the answers to the fundamental problems of humankind... I have laid a miraculous and victorious worldwide foundation. Such a foundation has been without precedence since the dawn of history."

Funky little teaching moment...

Actually, an argument could be made that the Unification Church was technically started years earlier, by the aged woman, Kim Seong-do

The day after Easter in 1923, Kim Seong-do had a revelation from God that the Fall of Man was due to sexual sin between Adam and Eve before they had been officially married as husband and wife by God (NOTE: Her focus on the special toxicity of sexual sin may have been informed by the fact that her pastor had just been accused of adultery, and the fact that her own husband regularly visited local concubines for sex)







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 - ◆ The day after Easter in 1923, Kim Seong-do has a revelation from God that the Fall of Man was due to sexual sin between Adam and Eve before they had been officially married as husband and wife by God
 - Kim Seong-do came up with the central ideas of what would later become Sun Myung Moon's "Divine Principle"—
 - 1) Mankind fell due to sexual sin
 - 2) God was heartbroken by His inability to prevent the fall of man and by the crucifixion of Jesus
 - 3) The death of Jesus was not part of God's plan, but an unforeseen mistake
 - 4) Christ would someday return to Earth
 —in Korea, the new chosen nation
 - 5) We must change our blood lineage to that of the Messiah







Funky little teaching moment...

Actually, an argument could be made that the **Unification Church was technically started years** earlier, by the aged woman, Kim Seong-do

Two of her disciples were Kim Baek-moon and Park Tae-seon, who practiced a special ritual called the pikareum (피가름) or "blood separation"

For instance, Park Tae-seon taught that he "received the precious blood of Jesus, the blood became his, and he was distributing the blood to others"

"Archangel Michael, fallen as the serpent, committed adultery with Eve and because of that serpent's blood, and all Eve's children including Cain carried the original sin. Therefore one can sanctify one's blood by having intercourse with Park because his body is blessed and sanctified. And the one with separated blood can sanctify others by having intercourse with them. This doctrine of orgies was used to forge mental and spiritual unity among his followers"
—according to History of Christianity in Korea



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Others, such as Kim Baek-moon's disciple, Sun Myung Moon, took Kim Seong-do's teachings in the completely opposite direction of total sexual purity

(NOTE: Sun Myung Moon would later write that he was never actually Kim Baek-moon's disciple—

"Some people say that Rev. Moon was Kim Baek-moon's disciple. What would I gain from that? He was a Christian, and according to his Christology, Jesus was God. He didn't know the fundamental Principle."


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 - Who is their founder?
 - Rev. Sun Myung Moon

Yong Myung Moon was born in Korea in 1920, and his family later converted to Christianity in 1930 and Yong himself experienced his own vision at Easter in 1935 that he would be a great evangelist (NOTE: He thus decided to change his name from "Yong" [용] meaning "Dragon" to "Sun" [선] meaning "Fish" or "Lamb" because he wanted to be associated with Christ rather than with the Devil)






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 - In 1940, Moon wrote the book, *The Divine Principle*, sharing God's "Unification Principle" with everyone (i.e.; as the textbook for the summer course that I taught on World Religions summarized well, "God created the universe in order to manifest true love, and the human family is considered the primary institution for the growth of love.")






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 - In 1940, Moon wrote the book, *The Divine Principle*, sharing God's "Unification Principle" with everyone—but ultimately spent five years in a North Korean prison camp when he tried to share his faith
 - But Moon was undaunted, and—returning to South Korea—he began The Holy Spirit Association for the Unification of World Christianity in 1954 (i.e.; the Unification Church)






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 - Given what was going on in Korea, why would you say that the concepts of unification and restoration were so poignant to a South Korean?






- Let's go through our six questions...
 - Do they have any authoritative writings or scriptures in addition to or instead of the Bible?
 - Divine Principle, various revelations and sermons by Moon
 - "The Divine Principle expresses a truth which is universal. It inherits and builds upon the core truths which God revealed through the Jewish and Christian scriptures and encompasses the profound wisdom of the Orient."
 - —from the Divine Principle translation committee
 - At its core, the Divine Principle teaches that mankind has fallen because of sin, that modern sins like sexual infidelity and communism have eroded our spiritual foundation, that strong Christian marriages are essential to the strength of the Church, and that we all need to come back to spiritual unity with God

(NOTE: If you find yourself nodding and feeling a spiritual affinity to any of that, remember that *none* of that means what you probably mean by those words—and you just proved how the cult pulls new people in...)



- Let's go through our six questions...
 - Does the group view itself as the one true church, founded because the true gospel was lost in the early centuries of the church?
 - "Medieval feudal society buried Christianity alive. Even though the Reformation raised high the torch of new life, its flame could not turn back the sweeping tide of darkness... What is more, although Christian doctrine teaches that all humanity descended from the same parents, many citizens of Christian nations who profess this doctrine will not even sit together with their brothers and sisters of different skin colors. This illustrates the actual situation of today's Christianity, which has lost much of the power to put the words of Jesus into practice. It has become a house of lifeless rituals, a whitewashed tomb."












The Daoist concept of "yin and yang"



So why is there a "yin" dot in the "yang" area, and a "yang" dot in the "yin" area?

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 - "Everything in the creation exists only because of a reciprocal relationship between its dual characteristics of positivity and negativity. We naturally conclude that God, being the First Cause of all creation, also exists because of a reciprocal relationship between the dual characteristics of positivity and negativity... God's essential character and His essential form assume a reciprocal relationship with His "essential positivity" and "essential negativity." Therefore, God's essential positivity and essential negativity are the attributes of His essential character and essential form... We call the positivity and negativity of God "masculinity" and "femininity," respectively."

 - To prove his point, Moon cited Genesis 1:27— "God created man in his own image, in the image of God created he him; male and female created he them"



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





And that was Christ's mistake—He was never supposed to be crucified, and that screwed up everything that God had planned for our restoration




"Adam and Eve should have been the True Parents of humanity. A physical and spiritual ideal world (Kingdom of Heaven) should have stemmed from them. However, they fell by sexual sin. Heavenly Father worked with fallen man to make a foundation to send a Second Adam, Jesus. Jesus, the Second Adam, should have fulfilled what Adam did not. Jesus should have grown to maturity, married a Second Eve, had children, and established a Kingdom of Heaven on Earth and in Heaven. However, he was not received by those prepared to welcome him, resulting in Jesus going the way of the cross. The cross gave spiritual salvation, but could not solve the entire problem of sin. Since Jesus could not fulfill his entire mission, Heavenly Father had to rebuild the foundation for True Parents, by sending the *Third* Adam, Sun Myung Moon. Rev.  Wackily enough, Moon and his wife were physically crowned King and Queen of the Kingdom of Heaven in Washington, D.C., in 2004

According to the Washington Post,

"More than a dozen lawmakers attended a congressional reception this year honoring the Rev. Sun Myung Moon in which Moon declared himself the Messiah... At the March 23 ceremony in the Dirksen Senate Office Building, Rep. Danny K. Davis (D) wore white gloves and carried a pillow holding an ornate crown that was placed on Moon's head..."

 Moon appreciated the expression of adulation, saying in his speech,

"Emperors, kings and presidents who enjoyed opulence and power on earth, and even journalists who had worldwide fame, have now placed themselves at the forefront of the column of the true love revolution... They have declared to all Heaven and Earth that Reverend Sun Myung Moon is none other than humanity's Savior, Messiah, Returning Lord and True Parent."



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 - For the record, most of those leaders in attendance later admitted that they had no idea who Moon was



(they just went to the event because it was a presented as a big Washington photo op sponsored by the *Washington Times*—which is one of the national newspapers owned by the Unification Church)


Let's go through our six questions...



- In 2003, the American Clergy Leadership Conference launched a national "Take Down the Cross" initiative
 - Multiple Christian congregations agreed with the Unification Church-founded group that the cross was a reminder of pain and suffering (instead of His glory) that needlessly divides people of different faiths
 - So Archbishop Dr. Angel M. Torres of New York's Pentecostal Family Center took down their cross as part of their re-enactment of Jesus' crucifixion
 - Bishop C. Phillip Johnson and members of the New Prospect Family Praise and Worship Center in Washington, D.C., did as well
 - As did Rev. John Kingara at the Worldwide Greater Mission Church in Worchester, MA
 - As did several other Christian churches, who even participated in burial services for their crosses draped in a burial shroud made from the flag of the American Clergy Leadership Conference
 - In the place of the cross, the ACLC suggested churches hang either their own, neutral symbol or a golden crown to commemorate Christ as the Lord of the Second Advent

See, Sun Myung Moon and his wife constitute the "True Parents"—the fleshly incarnation of God in His perfect, male-and-female, yang-and-yin form —clearly more perfect than Jesus ever was, since He never got married, and wrongly remained alone

Moon thus commanded his followers to forever abandon their "false" families here on Earth, get married, and start new families in the Unification Church, following the example of their *True* Parents

(Please ignore the fact that Moon's first wife had divorced him back in 1957 because she thought he was lines say







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30,000 cult members all at once

(NOTE: These marriages were guaranteed to last, since Moon himself would pick out your spouse for you)







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Since the Moons were the "True Parents" to us all, then it would be an act of cruelty to send their "True Family" members back to broken, imperfect families —therefore, members of the church were no longer allowed to have any contact with their birth families

(which made total sense to young converts to the church, after they'd had a few weekend retreats where they never got any sleep, rarely got any food, and were "love bombed" by other church members—and yes, those are all classic "brain





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 - Moon thus commanded his followers to forever abandon their "false" families here on Earth
 - Since the Moons were the "True Parents" to us all, then it would be an act of cruelty to send their "True Family" members back to broken, imperfect families —therefore, church members were no longer allowed to have any contact with their birth families
 Not surprisingly, several families began hiring detectives to find and even "kidnap" their children back—even taking them to "de-programmers" to try
 - Remember–lots of "brainwashing" cults popped up across America at this time, like Scientology in 1952 and in the 1960s, David Berg's "Children of God" and the "Hare Krishna" movement... etc.
 - But as of 1991, members are now encouraged to talk with their "old" families and evangelize them









As Moon explains—

"From the beginning, man's body was created to turn to dust after it ages and dies. Therefore, the human body, once it is dissolved into dust, cannot be resurrected to its original state. It is not necessary for the spirit man to resume his flesh, when there is a vast spirit world where he is supposed to go and live forever. Therefore, "resurrection" means the phenomena occurring in the process of man's restoration, from the state of having fallen under Satanic dominion back to the direct dominion of God."



As Moon said of his own legacy, "What would have happened if Christianity and Korea had welcomed me? I could have absorbed Protestant America over the course of seven years. And if I had begun working on the world level after the seven-year course finished in 1952, I would have mobilized all the world's statesmen by the time I was forty years old, leading them in one direction, toward the goal of making the kingdom of heaven on earth. That was the original providential plan. Christianity has made a unified, global territory after four thousand years of Judeo-Christian history. If Christianity had followed me, a unified physical and spiritual world would have come about..."
